

Mart Stam Prize 2023

The Mart Stam Prize

The Mart Stam Society, which is the friends' association of the weissensee school of art and design berlin, together with the mart stam foundation for art + design, is inviting entries from graduates from the academic year 2022-23 for the 2023 Mart Stam Prize. The prize consists of an exhibition and a catalogue. The exhibition of the winning entries will take place at Kunstquartier Kreuzberg / Bethanien from 5 to 17 June 2024, and will be curated by Stéphane Bauer.

Selection criteria

The Mart Stam Prize is an award for outstanding final-year assignments (on bachelor's, master's and diploma courses) from all specialist areas of the weissensee school of art and design berlin. The graduates with the best chances are those who convince the jury with the artistic and/or design quality of their work and who, at the same time, tread new paths, come up with surprising solutions and think beyond the boundaries of their particular discipline.

Eligibility

Graduates of the weissensee school of art and design berlin who completed their practical and theoretical examinations between 25 October 2022 and 23 October 2023 and who are able to present corresponding confirmation of this are entitled to apply. The postgraduate assignments of Meisterschüler cannot be submitted. The prize can only be awarded once. A repeat application is not possible. Participation in this competition requires that applicants are prepared to make their work and materials available for the exhibition and the catalogue. The award of the prize obliges the recipient to actively support the preparation of the catalogue and the setting up of the exhibition.

The application consists of a single pdf file in A4 format. The file includes:

1. Completed application form (see page 3). Short statements by your mentors may be included, but do not have to be.
2. Curriculum vitae (max. 1 page)
3. Presentation of your thesis, max. 10 pages: pictures and short explanatory text.
If you would like to supplement your application with videos, include appropriate links in your portfolio so that the jury can view them on one of the standard platforms (Youtube, Vimeo). Videos that complement your portfolio must not be longer than 5 minutes. If your thesis consists of a video, this limit does not apply.
4. Confirmation that you have successfully completed your studies

Conversation with the jury

The applicants will present their projects to the jury in person on 1 November between 10 am and 5 pm. The set-up will take place from Monday, 30 October to Tuesday, 31 October and will be coordinated by the setup team. Depending on availability, the walls of the exhibition system, plinths and tables can be used for your presentation. The projection equipment installed in the auditorium is available for showing videos. The exhibition space will be divided up according to the number of applicants so that everyone has space to present their work appropriately. Dismantling will take place on 3 November. The schedule (presentations in alphabetical order) will be communicated to the applicants in time.
